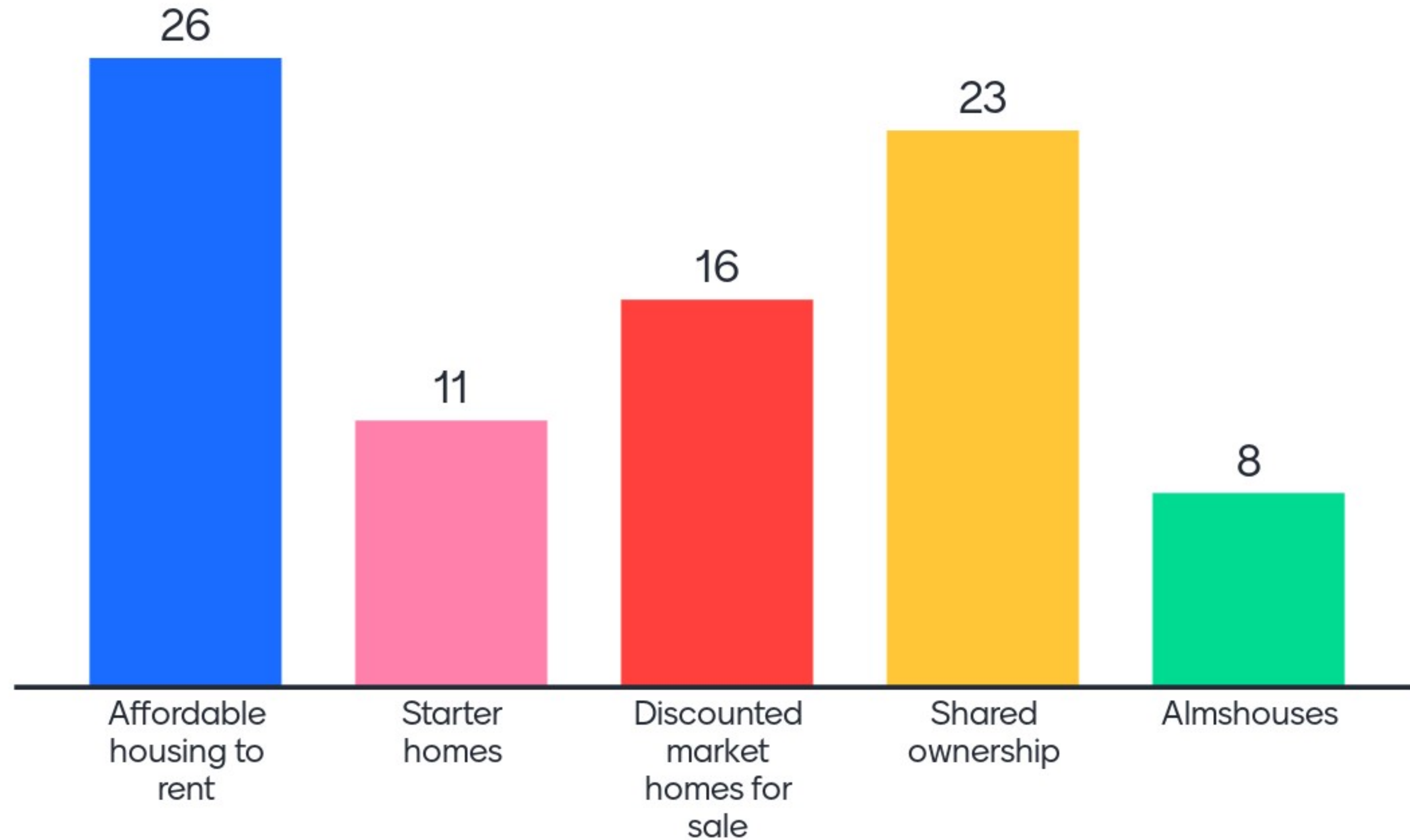
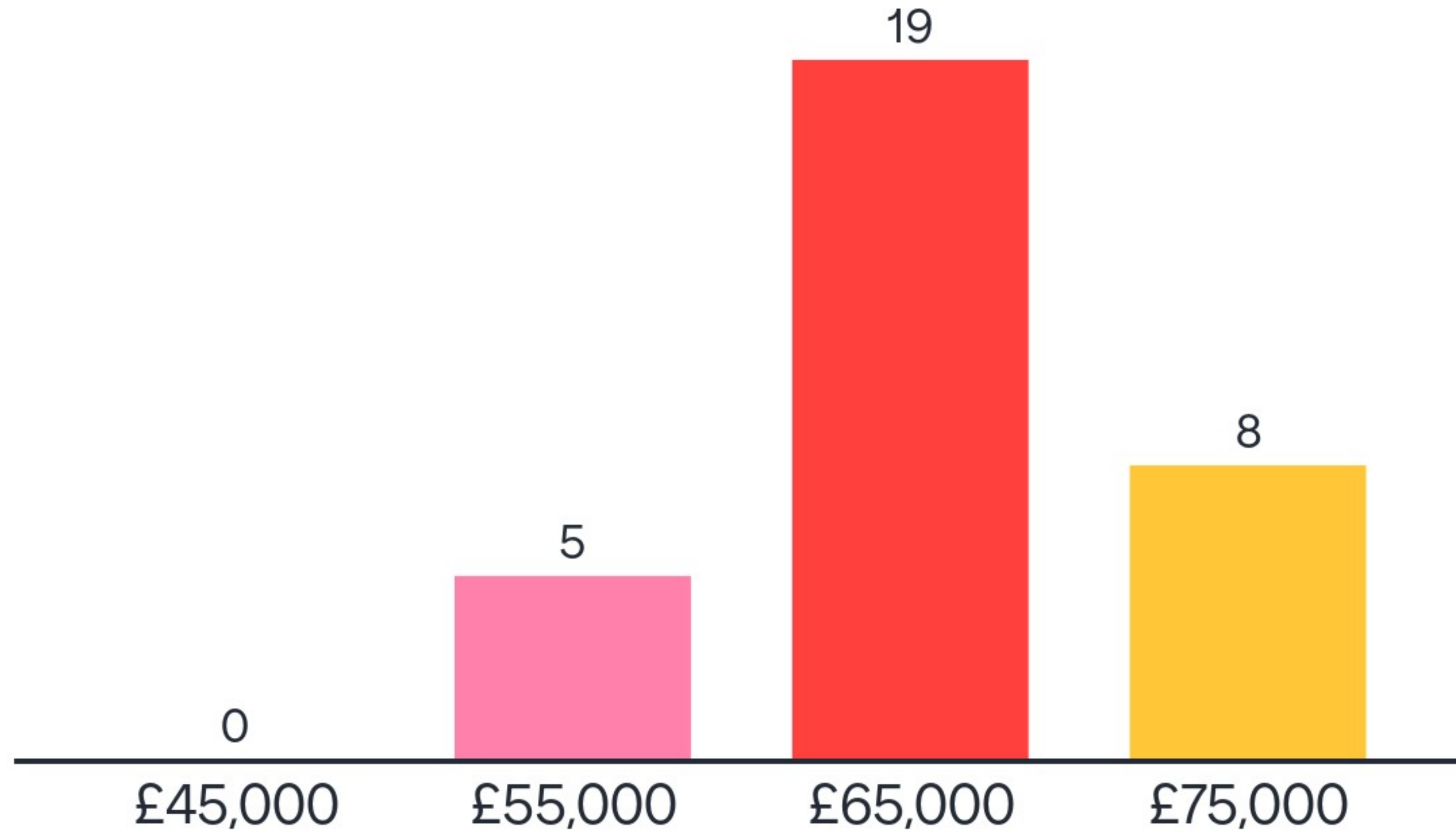


Which of these are described by national planning policy as affordable housing?
